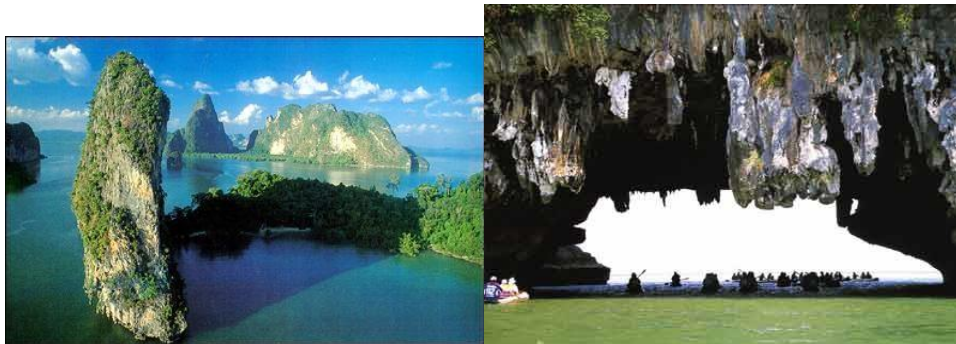


Phanak Island, Koh Hong (PNB), James Bond Island, and Chicken Island

08:30 hrs. Pick up with the hotel Limousine

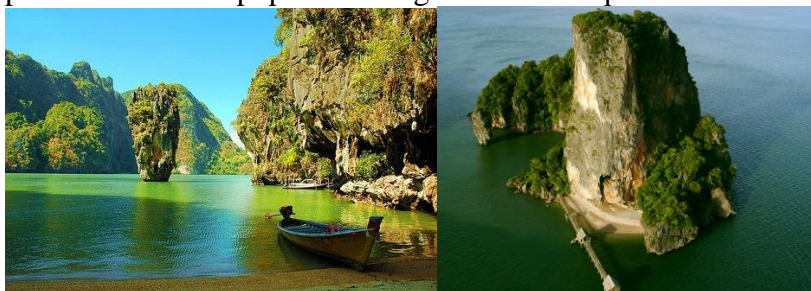
09:00 hrs Board MY Olympia 76 at Ao Po Grand Marina, cruise North to the spectacular rock formations of **Phang Nga Bay**. The first stop will be **Phanak Island** which features a spectacularly beautiful cave with exquisite stalactites and stalagmites. The cave also has small waterfalls of regular descent inside.



Kayak through the heart of the surrounding uninhabited islands to discover stunning caves such as the ones in **Koh Hong Island**, this is one of 42 islands located in the National Park in Phang-Nga Bay. The island of “rooms”, -Hong literally means room- is a breathtaking beauty, characterized by shallow coral reefs and fine, sandy beaches. In the middle of the half-circle shaped island lays the 'secret' lagoon, where you can find the purest of nature.



13:00 hrs Anchor for lunch off the famous **James Bond Island** - known originally and locally as Ko Tapu or Nail Island- found fame through the 1974 Bond film "The Man with the Golden Gun". The signature of this spectacular island is a rocky pinnacle which is popular amongst Thailand's postcards.



15:00 hrs Cruise towards **Chicken Island**, this island takes its common name after the 100 meter high limestone tower which stretches up crowned by a huge lump of limestone that resembles the head of a chicken. One end of the island consists of steep cliffs, while the other end has beautiful beaches along a sloping peninsula. Spend the afternoon exploring the island or swimming in the translucent waters.



16:30 hrs Cruise back to Ao Po Grand Marina
